As previously discussed, the dumpster at the hall continues to be misused. Small items and bags are acceptable trash collection is missed or forgotten. Please do not place large items in the township hall parking lot; this has been occurring and is unacceptable. Large items may be collected from your home free of charge by calling Republic services. Two spring clean-up dumpsters had been placed at the hall mid-April in previous years. Unfortunately, misuse (excessive overfilling, large item abandonment, etc.) has persisted. Therefore, the service has been reconsidered and discontinued. Overfilling and discarding of large items in the hall dumpster continues. Dumpsters are being monitored and citations will be issued to those committing these offenses. Township ordinances and ordinance enforcement policies are being updated and the Bay County Sherrif and Bay County District Court will begin issuing civil infractions with fines to residents who refuse to cooperate with township enforcement officials.
